

With the entire U.S. basically "shut down," many of our confirmed mission conferences were cancelled for the month of March and April. However, just before the quarantine, we were able to participate in a mission's conference in Buffalo, NY. We were able to share our burden for those not only behind bars, but the tremendous need to help these individuals once they are released. A special thanks to Pastor Donath for opening his doors during an unprecedented time with this virus!

Due to the restrictions that the Governor of NY set into place, I was not allowed to go into the Monroe County Jail (MCJ) and all other state facilities during much of March. However, I was contacted by the Chaplin from MCJ and was asked if I would be interested in returning during the closures. Only 3 other individuals beside me are

allowed at the jail this time. Although my weekly Thursday bible study in the Mainframe has been put on hold, I have been able to reach many new individuals on different floors of this jail. Since April 6th, we have sent out 75 or more KJV bibles! We have estimated that over the course of one year at MCJ we have given over 300 KJV bibles! Now, in no disrespect to other ministries, but we do not send/give paperback KJV bibles. We go the extra mile and give leather-like, soft cover bibles. I have not seen any of the bibles we have given thrown on the floor at the jail, or pages thrown over the hallways... These men cherish these bibles. These bibles are allowed to go home with the individuals or follow them to the prison they go to. It is all thanks to the people like you who support Liberty Behind Bars and their donations that help this cause!

Since being back at MCJ, the devotionals have also increased. We are now close to 150 mailings that go out every 3 weeks! Please continue to pray that this door stays open for me to go to MCJ during this quarantine.

Close to 4 years ago I met a woman that was in the Allegany County Jail. Just recently she has been transferred back to her home in California to serve out her 7 years. It is amazing of the influx of new people from California that we are in contact with now because of her! We are also receiving many requests from Florida and some northern states!

Currently we do have a preaching meeting scheduled for May 16th. However, it is "touch and go" with the closures still in place. I have been told that it would be rescheduled if need be.

We would like to make a trip to our supporting churches this summer and to present the ministry to new churches. Currently it is recommended that travel not be done. We are praying the state borders will be opened and that we can travel freely visiting these churches!

As for my family and I...

Honestly, this COVID-19 quarantine has been wonderful for our family. Many of you know that due to my past, my wife has had to work and my children have had to go to public school. Since my wife is a special education teacher, she and the kids have been home since the middle of March! We absolutely have been blessed to be able to "home-school" and work from home! Please keep this in prayer as well, as we would love to keep our children home and not return to public school. However, unless the Lord deems it, Amy will still need to work.

I was scheduled to have my 13th back surgery to have my stimulator replaced in March. However, all elective surgeries have been placed on hold due to the virus. It has been moved to the end of May, but we will see. Please keep this in prayer as well!

Please also pray as my employment continues to decrease due to my physical abilities. However, this may be the Lord's doing so I can have more time for the ministry. If this is the case, please pray that the Lord give me wisdom on whether to continue to work or not. If not, that He would provide for our family...

Continue to pray for God's intervention in this ministry... if He does not show up in the jails and lives of these men and women - then I'd be better off sitting in a pew at the church. These people do not need another "religious worker!" Jesus Christ is the only one who can make a difference in ANY person's life!
