

My goodness! It has been a whirlwind since our last letter! God has been so good to the ministry and to our family!

We have had the opportunity to present our ministy to many churches in New York, PA, and Maine since March. Almost every church we presented at - our family left BLESSED! Some decided to support our ministry financially...others have dedicated themselves to praying for it! Both are tremendous to LBB! Prayer moves God just as well (if not more) than monetary gifts! The friendships we have acquired is priceless.

On three different occasions we were chosen as a church's VBS missionary. The outpouring love from the children and adults from these churches overwhelmed us! Not only did we get to minister to their children, but they ministered unto us!

Month of July: We spent most of July up in Maine. It was amazing how the Lord provided every need! Whether it was housing, food, fellowship, spiritual needs, and financial - HE met it ALL! While we were up in Maine, we did hear from three churches that they were taking us on for support! One was not even from Maine! God has been showing his faithfulness every step of the way!

Month of August: While in Maine, we ran into some dear friends in the ministry. They invited us to their first ever tent meeting in Ohio. WOW what a week of revival! There were 7 people who made a profession of salvation! To God be the Glory! There were countless others who rededicated their lives to Christ and made decisions of full submission! We met many new sweet friends and renewed deep friendships with others! Only God can do such amazing things!

In between - we have had several Men's meeting at our home church (Black Creek Baptist Church). The power that has reigned down has been marvelous!

New exciting opportunity at Monroe County Jail (MCJ):

The Sheriff's administration approached me a few months ago about bringing me in as an independent contractor. This is still a work in progress and we pray that everything could be finalized within the next few months.

What this **DOESN'T** mean...

MCJ will not ask me to use different bibles, preach a different gospel, or compromise any of my beliefs. They are considering me as a resource because of what Jesus Christ has done with me and now able to help the men and women in their jail. Just as Joseph and Daniel worked along side authority (government officials) without compromising their God, so the Lord is using LBB in this same fashion.

What this **DOES** mean...

I have better access in the jail. I will be able to have more flexibility in when I can meet with the individuals (up to 40 hours a week if needed). Unless for security reasons, I will be able to work with all the individuals housed in MCJ. I will be able to counsel the men (and soon to be women with the help of my wife Amy) and assist transition needs - whether to prison or home. I will also have the opportunity to transport newly released individuals to housing, bring individuals to parole and probation appointments, and places pertaining to addition treatment programs.

There may be other opportunities within the jail to work with individual family members as well. It is so important to bridge relationships in Jesus Christ in order for lasting change to occur.

Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. When the Lord tells you it is time to do something, as impossible as it looks, you must obey. Through the grace of God, Amy resigned her position as a special education teacher. We are excited to have her home, teaching our children and working full time in the ministry!
