

Fight the Good Fight

2 Timothy 2:3 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Approximately 6 months after salvation, I distinctly remember the Lord telling me to, "strap-up the boots," and be ready for the battle. Being such a new Christian, I really did not understand what that all entailed. Summer Ministry Trip

Typically we travel in the summer to various churches down south who support LBB. Although we enjoy these visits tremendously, the Lord would not give peace about going. For many weeks, I prayed about where the Lord wanted us to go. The state of Maine kept resonating in my thoughts, but I waited for confirmation. A week later, I received a call to prayerfully consider making a trip to Maine. It floored me that it was Maine!



I made arrangements with one church to preach and present the ministry. However, that was the only open door LBB had. On that Sunday, not knowing where the Lord wanted us to go, an evangelist asked if we would join him for a meeting that was taking place north of where we were. Housing had been provided for, so we trusted the Lord and left. The Lord was so gracious and faithful in providing everything for our family. During the next two weeks, we met various pastors and the doors started to open for us to give our testimonies, present the ministry, and to preach God's Word.

After one meeting I ran into an evangelist who used to preach at a prison that I was incarcerated in 20 years ago. This same man, who has been faithful all these years, asked me if I would come to his church to give my testimony, preach, and present the ministry. I was blown away with this. God is so good!

During another time, sitting around a campfire with two pastors and their families, enjoying various testimonies and how the Lord has worked in each of our lives, I was asked to testify/present at one of the pastor's church. Later that night, I received a call to preach during a impromptu special meeting from the other pastor! The doors kept opening. Overall, we had the opportunity to be in 6 different churches and met some wonderful Christian brothers and sisters.

This trip was such a testimony to the Morey family on how the Lord works when you just trust him. We have learned to just allow the Lord to guide and he is faithful to provide!
